The classroom teachers dance with the children during large group time and also perform kid yoga with them. Weather permitting, the children have an hour of outdoor play per day. The teachers have planned a water days for summer program including large water blasters, large buckets of soapy water and paintbrushes and water and running through sprinklers.</p>
